

Student Sponsorship AAGE

2016/2017 Academic Term

Thanks to the support from our sponsors, AAGE is able to offer reduced fees to some of our families. You must fulfill all of the following requirements in order to apply for a Student Sponsorship.

- Applicants must have a maximum annual household income of 200.000 DKK
OR
- Applicants must have an international background AND be employed by an educational institution in a teaching or research capacity.

To receive the discount, the applicant must support AAGE in educational development (e.g. give a guest lecture, host field trip, provide workshop, etc.)

Applicants are free to determine how they wish to present their application. However, the following information is mandatory:

- Proof of household income
OR
- Letter from employer confirming their employment at an educational institution.
- A personal statement as to the reason for the application for a sponsorship at AAGE, including what you can contribute to the school.

If you are eligible for the AAGE sponsorship, please send your application to the school's administration at administration@aarhusacademy.dk no later than by the first day of school. Please put "Application for student sponsorship" in the subject field.

Reduced Student Tuition Fees:

After School Activities (PYP4-8):

If the child is enrolled in ASA and has a CPR number by September 5, ASA is free of charge.

If the child enrolls in ASA after 5 September or if the child does not have a CPR number by 5 September, the monthly fee is DKK 1000 per child.

All other school fees apply as usual. Further discounts are not available under this agreement.

Please note that if your situation changes (change in household income or employment) you are obliged to inform AAGE.
